


What is it?

The Scottish Quality Langoustine (SQL) scheme was developed through the Scottish Nephrops Program to manage product quality. Over the past three years, Scottish government funding has supported the langoustine industry's recovery post-Brexit and Covid. The scheme was shaped by feedback from both the catching sector and processors. The scheme will be fully owned by the industry, providing assurance to the supply chain and a response mechanism to global questions posed to its fishing and processing activities.

The SQL Scheme is founded on the following key areas that underpin the brand proposition.
